As we enter the end of the summer the council is still bustling with activity. Upcoming we have the Kites Near Lake Michigan event and Ethnic Fest which are our final fundraisers of the year. As in past years the focus for the state council is on membership growth. This year to be able to attain Star Council status we need to bring in 8 new Brother Knights. We have been able to attain Star Council for the last three years running. We need to continue this trend. If you know a member of the parish or a Catholic gentleman that might be a good possible Brother Knight simply ask them. The power of a personal invitation is often all that is needed to get the gentlemen interested. If you aren't comfortable with doing so ask a member of the membership team lead by Brother Jeff Thompson and they will take it from there.

If you are a first degree Knight and are looking to advance you can do so by observing the initiation degree. We plan to offer this at our October meeting following our September membership drive.

At the past meeting President of Roncalli Schools John Stelzer spoke to the council about the One to One program as it relates to the newly proposed Roncalli Elementary School building project and supporting our parish needs as well. This diocesan fundraising program is intended to support both diocesan as well as local needs. However, given the building program and fundraising for the school, all local donations will stay local. The council discussed this program and a motion was made to donate \$10,000 to the program over a 5 year span of time. This motion of intent was made and approved by the council. However, due to our council bylaws it does need to be voted upon again to finally approve it. The council is able to donate \$5,000 of this pledge immediately and will use our fundraisers to come up with the balance. The council has resolved to split the pledge between the parish needs and the needs of the school.

If you have questions about this please attend the meeting in September where it will be discussed and voted on finally.


