Set up of the Community Nativity will be this Saturday the 26th at 9:00 in Central Park. This year it will be on the East side of the park. We start at the KC club house to load up the nativity icons and the move down to the park to install them. This generally takes less than an hour and many hands make light work on this!

Our council ordered and delivered 3 cases of Coats as part of our Coats for Kids program. This year they were delivered to TREP and will be dispensed throughout the year as needed.

Additionally, we received a charity rebate from the State Council as part of our charity raffle ticket sales. This over \$1200 was added to our charity account to help promote our charitable events throughout the year.

Thank you to the Brother Knights that helped in the Forty Days for Life March in Manitowoc.

The council is also supporting a diaper and wipe drive for the Crossing at the Parish.

At our recent meeting members of our council discussed that the Crossing is looking for a new 4D ultrasound machine. The Knights of Columbus had donated their original ultrasound unit through the Supreme initiative for Ultrasounds in Crisis pregnancy centers. The council noted that the funds raised from the Cornhole Tournament in February will go toward this program. Additionally, other councils in the district will be asked to support this and we will work with State Right to Life Director Dan Miller to help recruit donations from councils throughout the state. With the program if the state or local council raises 50% of the cost of the machine, the Supreme council will donate the balance to help purchase the machine. More to come on this exciting program.
