Next month we will be voting for the council Family of the Year. Please make sure to review the write ups for each of the very worthy families of the month who were nominated for this award.

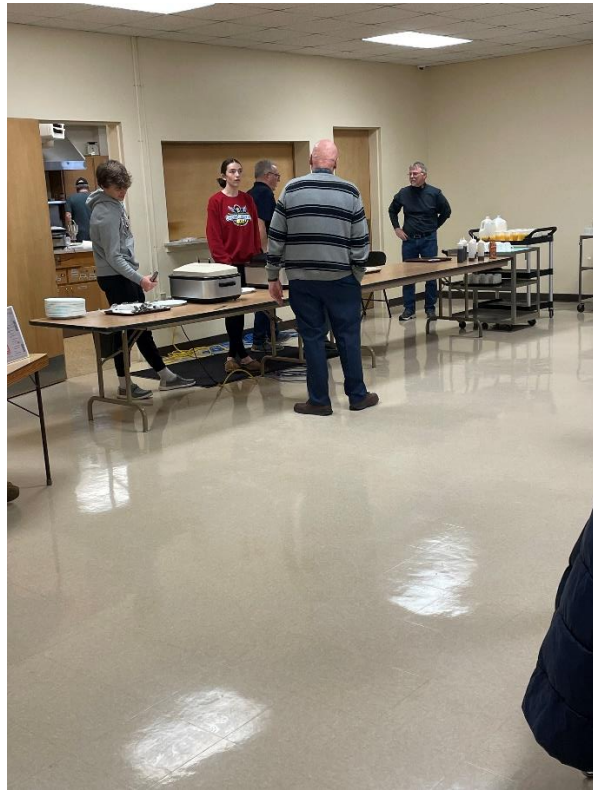
Community
